# <u>our hotel</u>

Join us as return once again to our new home in Los Angeles - the LAX Marriott! The hotel is conveniently located right next to LAX International Airport, only five minutes west of the 405 Freeway, and only eight minutes north of the 105 Freeway. There is plenty of parking at the Marriott, and for folks travelling by air, there is a 24-hour complementary Marriott shuttle from LAX.

Room rates will be \$93, single/double, triple/quad.

You might remember from last year, that our convention space is all on one floor, just below the lobby of the Marriott. You will also be able to access your sleeping rooms easily and directly from the convention floor by one of six elevators. Foods choices abound at JW's – serving steaks and seafood, Latitude 33, themed as "tastes of the Pacific Rim", and Champions American Sports Bar, with a reasonable priced smaller selection menu (burgers, salads, etc.). There's also a Starbucks, which will be open all weekend.
